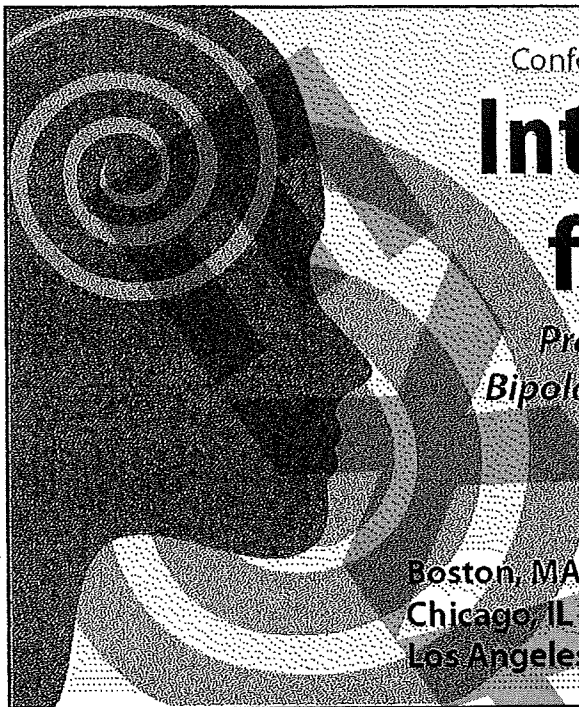

Overview
